- use of public resources (inviting specialists, excursions) — social projects (social projects, contests, radio and newspapers, films, demonstrations, exhibitions, performances, songs and tales)
- learning and strengthening of new materials (interactive working with lecture, demonstration manuals, video and audio materials, "student as teacher", "everyone teaches everyone")
