Critical Thinking is essential for analyzing texts, constructing arguments, and evaluating different perspectives. According to Brookfield [5;45], students who develop critical thinking skills are better prepared to navigate complex information environments and become independent learners.

Creativity inspires students to use language in innovative and personal ways. Activities that involve storytelling, drama, poetry, and digital media creation allow learners to explore language beyond grammar drills, as noted by Maley and Peachey [4;28]. These approaches make learning more engaging and memorable.

Together, these four skills promote a holistic learning experience that aligns with the needs of today's students. By embedding the 4Cs into everyday teaching practices, educators foster not only linguistic competence but also the soft skills required for lifelong learning and global citizenship.
